Criteria for Success

Generating your Discussion Topic

- Does your discussion topic help accelerate Project Management into the future?
- Is your discussion topic innovative yet technologically feasible?
- Is there a need and sufficient motivation for people to engage?
- Is this the first time your approach has been discussed?

Video/Poster Submission

- Have you clearly identified the key issues to consider on your topic?
- Have you researched existing solutions?
- Have you consulted experts to explore options?
- Does your video deliver a clear message?
- Is your video compelling and engaging?
- Does your video encourage discussion?
- Have you used English in delivering your topic?
- Have you uploaded your video in YouTube?

Tips: Presenters displaying confidence and clarity will be considered favorably.

Make sure to include your name, degree, and University in the first frame of your video.

Promoting your Video Entry

- Have you used Twitter, Facebook and Instagram in promoting your YouTube video/ Poster?
- Have you liked and followed GAPPS Twitter, Facebook and Instagram accounts?
- Have you used #GAPPSLOTF in your posts?
- Does the 140-character description of your post deliver a clear message about the content of your video?

Tip: Entries with the most likes in YouTube will be considered favorably.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Am I eligible to participate?

You are eligible to participate in this competition if you are an undergraduate or postgraduate student currently enrolled in a Project Management degree accredited by the PMI Global Accreditation Center (GAC) for Project Management Education programs. However, you are not eligible to join if you have filial relationship with any staff, management or directors of GAPPS as well as any entity/suppliers in

respect of the competition.

Is there any restrictions regarding content, language, subject matter?

While there are no specific restrictions on content or subject matter, you are encouraged to think laterally about Project Management, and to present a discussion topic that is relevant and engaging. The video must be delivered in English language and must be uploaded in YouTube.

Do I have to compete in a team, and if so, how many members should I have?

You may compete as an individual or as a team. Regardless of the size of the team however, the total prize awarded to the winning individual or group is up to the value to maximum of AUD 1000.

How many video/poster entries can I upload?

A participant is allowed to upload one (1) video or one(1) poster entry only.

Do I have to register to participate?

While there is no separate registration needed, just make sure that you follow and like the Twitter, Facebook and Instagram accounts of GAPPS and tag them along in your promotions and campaigns. Always use also the hashtag #GAPPSLOTR in all your posts for ease of tracking. Failure to do so may result to non-consideration of the video entry. Remember to state your name, degree, and the University you are enrolled to in the first frame of your video entry so GAPPS can verify your eligibility.

What does the prize cover?

The total prize is up to the value of AUD 1000 of travel voucher.

The travel voucher is redeemable by the winner through a travel agency or other organization nominated by GAPPS. The travel voucher may only be used by the winner for travel-related expenses (i.e. flight ticket, land transportation or hotel accommodation) of one (1) person only to and from the venue of the GAPPS Thought Leadership Forum of your choice within one year from winning. Any amount exceeding the AUD 1,000 and all other associated expenses on travel (e.g. visa fee, travel insurance, etc.) will be in your account.

The prize also includes one (1) full registration for attendance at upcoming GAPPS Thought Leadership Forum. Light refreshment breaks and lunch will be provided over the 2 days of the forum, as well as dinner on the last night.

What can I do during the GAPPS Thought Leadership Forum?

The GAPS Thought Leadership Forum is a great opportunity to collaborate, engage and network with leading academic and industry practitioners in the field of project management. You may opt to have the chance of presenting your winning discussion topic to the forum and facilitate workshop session during the event.

How will the entries be judged?

Entries will be judged based on a number of criteria, including but not limited to, the number of likes on entries at the end of the competition period, level of creativity and innovation, and relevance to modern project management. The final winner will be determined at the discretion of the GAPPS Board.

Submit your entries via YouTube no later than 01 Jun 2019, 11:59 PM (AEST, Australian Eastern Standard Time). No entries will be accepted after this time. The earlier you upload, promote and campaign for your video, the higher the chance of getting more likes for your entry.
